

JUNE 2022 REPORT ON BIBLE, JUSTIFICATION BOOKLET READING AND JESUS FILM SHOWING PROGRAMS

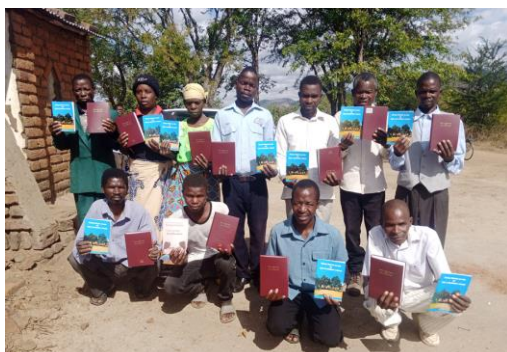
On 5th June 2022, we (Pastor Stephen Kring and Cheryl, Mary and I) travelled to Balaka turn-off EBCM whose current Pastor is Hastings Limbani. However, the visiting Pastor from Canada was the one who preached during the service while I interpreted the message into Chichewa.

We also used the opportunity to launch the Bible reading Program at the church which was newly planted. At that moment, they were just gathering for worship in a make-shift structure. We distributed a copy of the Chichewa bible plus a copy of the Justification booklet to 10 Christians from the church as shown in the picture below:



They expected to complete reading the whole New Testament in a space of 45 days or so. Thereafter, they would gain ownership of the bibles. Also, upon reading the Justification booklet, they would each person be given a copy of the chorus book as an additional gift.

On 12th June 2022, Mary and I went to Chigumula EBCM where we launched the Bible Reading Program to 11 people who comprised 10 Christians from the local church as well as 1 person that converted from Islam and came to join EBCM on that particular day. Since we had an extra bible with us, we thought it worthy to have him included in the reading program as a way of motivating him the more.



The above picture shows the person who came and joined EBCM from Islam. His name is Timothy Chikopa. 18 years of age.

On 15th June 2022, we made it to Namichere EBCM in Balaka for the Bible Reading Program. Also, later that evening we had Jesus Film Showing where an estimated over 400 people were in attendance. However, the attendees were encouraged to put on masks as a precautionary measure against the spread of Covid 19.



On 18th June 2022, we went to Kakwera EBCM in Mpini Umodzi, Ulongwe where the Jesus Film Showing attracted at least 500 people.



On 24th June 2022, we again travelled to Balaka Turn-off on a follow-up trip on the Bible Reading Program, where we joined them as they read the book of Luke Chapter 9 through 15.

On 26th June 2022, we went to Khwisa EBCM in Balaka where we launched the Bible Reading Program by handing over bibles to 10 participants who intended to finish reading the entire New Testament in the quickest time possible. We also gave them copies of the Justification booklet as well as the chorus book.



Lastly, on 27th June 2022, we travelled to Nampeya Church Centre where selected members representing 13 local churches gathered together for the Bible Reading Program. We distributed a total of 101 bibles at the launch of the reading program. We intend to make some follow-up trips in July this year in order to assess their progress and to give them a word of encouragement.

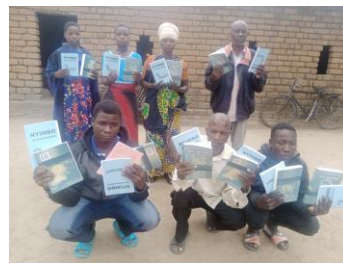
